Our Parish will be hosting the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima **on Tuesday, June 20th!** We will be having an all-day celebration with Eucharistic Adoration in the main body of the church. Our Blessed Lady's statue will be placed on display at 8:00 am with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament as regularly scheduled. We will have our 12:10pm daily Mass with the Blessed Sacrament exposed again after Mass. At 2:00, 3:00, 4:00 and 5:00pm we will pray the Most Holy Rosary. Following the 5:00 pm rosary there will be Benediction, followed by a talk given by the Statue of Our Lady's Custodian at 5:45—6:45pm. The Litany of Our Lady will be prayed, then a closing prayer. This is a great honor for our parish to have been chosen as one of five parishes in the Bismarck Diocese to share this beautiful statue of Our Lady of Fatima. Join us to honor and venerate our Blessed Mother who brought our Lord, Jesus Christ into the world for our salvation. Plan on spending some time in the presence of our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and pray for peace.

ANNULMENTS (Declarations of Nullity): The Tribunal of the Diocese of Bismarck assists Bishop David D. Kagan D.D., P.A., J.C.L., in his ministry to serve the people of our diocese. As a part of this ministry, the Office of Canonical Services is pleased to announce the implementation of an expanded service to this area. By way of video conferencing our tribunal staff is now available on a weekly basis to assist divorced Catholic and non-Catholic persons who may be seeking clarity and/or an explanation about the annulment process. *GoToMeeting* is a confidential and secure way to conduct online collaborative, face to face interviews and meetings between a tribunal auditor and anyone interested in the annulment process. An interview is recommended in order to begin the process. The purpose of the meeting would be to get a general overview of the basis for an annulment and to obtain the paperwork necessary to get the process started. Our secure and confidential sites are located at the Church of St. Wenceslaus, Dickinson; Church of Our Lady of Grace, Minot; and Church of St. Joseph, Williston.
