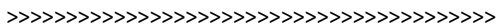

**September 30:** Confirmation Seminar/parent/student meeting, grade 10, 7-9 pm at Queen of Peace.

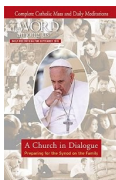
Starting the weekend of Sept. 27, there will be children’s Bulletins/fun sheets available in the church entrances.
