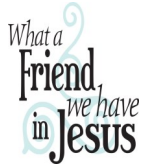

Father Karris will share personal witness about Food For The Poor's mission to care for the destitute as a means of living out the Gospel mandate to love one another.

Fr. Karris was ordained for the Franciscan Order in 1965. Before preaching on behalf of Food For The Poor, he taught at Catholic Theological Union in Chicago, was Provincial Minister of his Province, was General Councilor of the Order and was stationed in Rome. Besides preaching now on behalf of Food For The Poor, Fr. Bob is head of research at the Franciscan Institute at St. Bonaventure University in New York. He has published more than fifteen books.

Let us give Fr. Bob a sincere welcome to our parish.



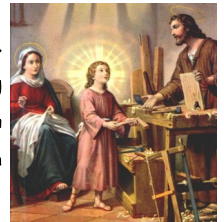
