**LENTEN REGULATIONS**

Lenten regulations for the Diocese of Bismarck are as follows:  
 Catholics who have celebrated their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday.  
 In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, until they celebrate their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to ones needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. These minimal penitential practices should not be lightly excused.

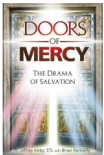
